

CHRONOLOGICAL HISTORY

1973 Group of visionary women open a small volunteer-run shelter for women and families in Calgary

Calgary Women's Emergency Shelter becomes a registered charity

Services for children developed

Calgary Women's Emergency Shelter moves to a new facility

Outreach Counselling Program begins

1991 Beginning of Men's Counselling Service

Start of youth prevention program: Healthy Relationships

1994 First Turning Points Fundraising Gala

1997 Shelter burns to the ground

New Shelter opens

2001 24-Hour Family Violence Helpline piloted

Shelter increases bed spaces from 35 to 40

2004 Start of Children's Outreach Program

2004 Men's Counselling Service begins partner support program

Court Support program initiated

In-house wellness clinic accessible for clients

Response Based approach embraced by agency

Phase I Shelter renovations: Shelter capacity increases from 40-50 spaces

Specialized child care services offered at Shelter

Phase II Shelter renovations commences

Calgary Women's Emergency Shelter commemorates 40 years of service to the community
